

Service Description – Emergency First Aid At Work

Conforming to the HSE requirements for Emergency First Aid at Work, this is a short sharp training course to provide the necessary skills to deal with life-threatening emergencies in the workplace, at home or in the leisure environment.

As with all Trauma Resus courses, the emphasis is on skills development with sound theory knowledge delivered by experts who really know their subject.



The course is delivered over 1 day, with emphasis on skills development, and with sound theory knowledge delivered by experts who really know their subject.

Upon completion of the course, students are awarded an Emergency First Aid at Work (EFAW) certificate, which is valid for one year.

This course is equivalent to PHEM (Pre-Hospital Emergency Medicine) Level B, as defined by the Faculty of Pre-Hospital Care for providers.
