

Service Description – ASHI CPR, AED and Basic First Aid Combination Training

This CPR, AED, and Basic First Aid combination training was created to allow instructors an easy option for their students seeking a comprehensive training class.

The program helps develop the knowledge, skills, and the confidence to respond to a medical emergency. CPR, AED, and Basic First Aid combination training is an excellent choice for both the community and workplace setting, and conforms to the 2015 Guidelines Update for CPR, ECC, and First Aid.

INTENDED AUDIENCE

- Individuals who are not healthcare providers or professional rescuers but desire or are required to be certified in basic emergency medical care, including certification in CPR and the use of an AED

CERTIFICATION PERIOD

- 2 years from month of issue

SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION (CERTIFICATION)

- Written evaluation: Required when specified by organizational, local, or state regulation. It is recommended for designated responders with a duty or employer expectation to respond in an emergency and provide first aid care.
- Performance evaluation: All students must perform required skills competently without assistance.

RECOMMENDED TIME TO COMPLETE

- Initial training: 4 - 5 hours
- Renewal training: Less than initial instructional time

Times based on core-topics only. Adding supplemental topics will add to the overall class time.
