

Service Description – MACER (Mass Casualty Event Responder)

The Mass Casualty Event Responder – MACER – Programme is designed to prepare Zero Responders to bridge “the care gap” and become a vital component part of Emergency Response Planning & Resilience for areas of high occupancy in the UK.

The MACER programme incorporates training, equipment, and clinical governance.

It is widely recognised that staff who work and operate in and around areas of mass occupancy, such as sports stadia, public transport hubs and retail real-estate, will be the first people on hand to deliver immediate life-saving skills when a major incident occurs on site.

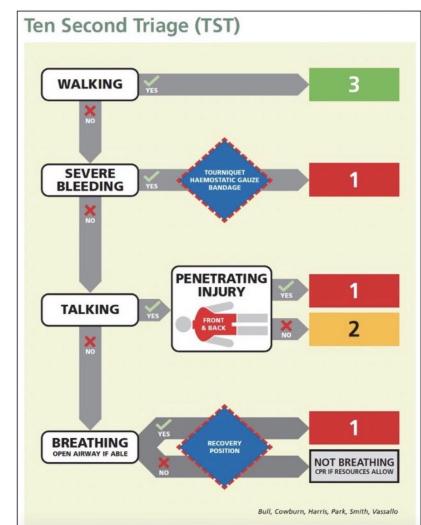
Basic first aid is no longer considered to be an adequate level of training for staff members who work in these areas, due to the risk and hazards they will unfortunately face, and the likely injuries that are often associated with major incidents.

The MACER programme has been designed to bridge the gap to ensure staff operating in these areas are prepared to deliver important lifesaving interventions.

MACER focuses upon providing participants with the knowledge, understanding and skills in :-

- The application of the Ten Second Triage (TST) Tool
- Immediate lifesaving interventions including major haemorrhage control and airway management
- Priming effective planning
- Preparation.

This will lead to high performing team members, who improve patient outcomes when responding to any emergency situation that may occur.



Participants will gain an improved understanding of the operational constraints that working in a stressful situation brings, the medical related terminology employed, and the requirements for inter-agency working. They will learn how to apply emergency first aid skills, including management of bleeding, and basic life support using an Automated External Defibrillator (AED).



MACER is a cross-certified HSE Emergency First Aid at Work Qualification.
